

SUMMER READING CHALLENGE: ADULTS



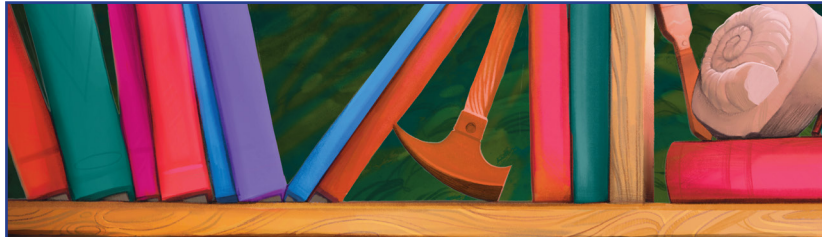
Read a book published in 2026 that you think will be read by future generations.
